CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE: Confined to Gundogs that have been placed first in a Restricted Stake or first, second or third in an All Age Stake or have the title All Age Retrieving Dog. Proof of eligibility MUST be provided if requested. A variety of game within rules will be used.

IMPORTANT NOTE: *ALL dogs and their handlers that finish the Championship are expected to remain on the grounds until ALL judging is complete, and are EXPECTED to stay at the trial campsite for the prize-giving presentation and photographs. This is essential to retain future sponsorship.*

AWARDS: Trophy and Sash 1st to 5th Place (for qualifying dogs only).

Special Prizes will include Highest Scoring Veteran (7+ years), Highest Scoring Golden Retriever, Youngest Dog to Complete Trial, Highest Scoring Lady Handler and a Teams Event. Full details available on trial website.

ENTRY FEES: \$50.00 per dog. All entry fees made out to "Dogs NSW Retrieving Trial Championship". Catalogue included with entry fee. Non exhibitor catalogues – \$5.00 per catalogue.

Fees MUST accompany a correctly completed entry form and include a stamped and self addressed envelope. Incomplete or illegible forms may be returned. Directions and map for the campsite will be sent along with your receipt. Please provide an email address with all entries to allow prompt receipting of entries and notification of updates.

Entries may be limited to 22 dogs, if this occurs a reserve list will be made.

The committee reserves the right to appoint additional or substitute judges with or without notice.

Draw will take place at 6pm on Friday, 23 August, 2019 at the trial campsite. Start order as per catalogue.

All competitors required to show their firearms licence/permit at vetting.
